



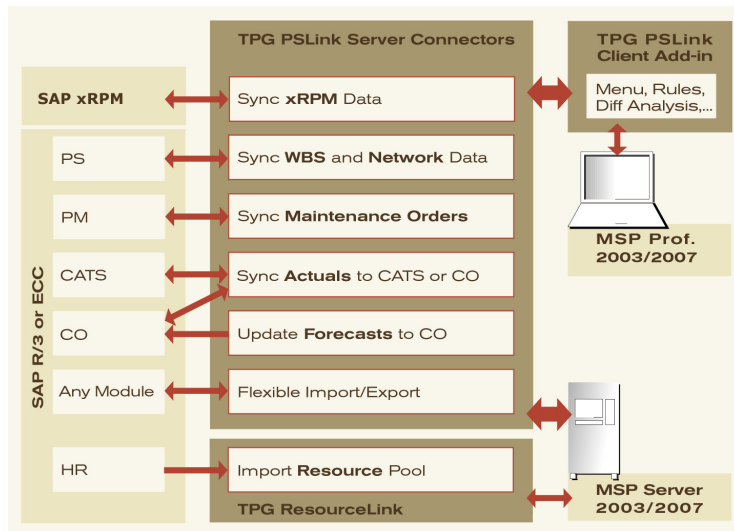

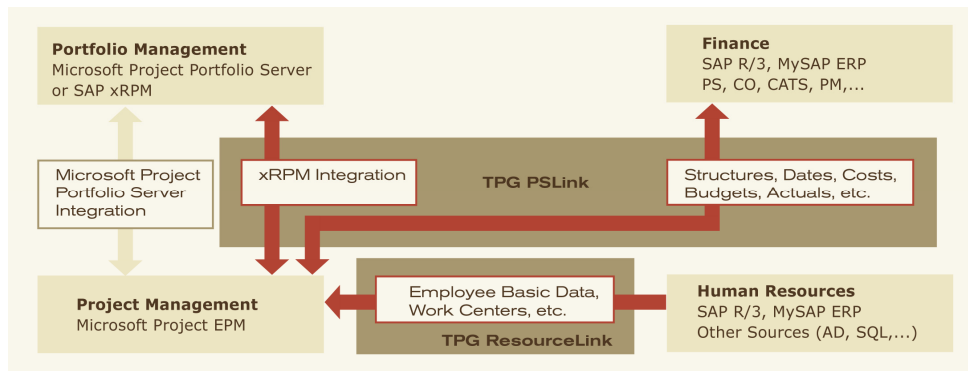

Business scenarios

TPG PSLink and TPG ResourceLink are connectivity products that are essential for designing and implementing company-wide project and portfolio management based on Microsoft and SAP. They combine portfolios, projects, finance and human resources in a well-integrated solution that increases your project management efficiency.



Integration use cases

The comprehensive configuration capabilities of PSLink enable you to define a broad spectrum of use cases – they cover almost all imaginable customer needs.

- Structures can be synchronized with SAP PS in both directions, as a whole or in sections. They can also be filtered by any criteria and be based on Microsoft Project tasks or on outline code field definitions.
- PSLink covers a wide range of SAP network-based use cases, including mapping tasks with SAP network activities. The link can be one-to-one or one-to-many. For example, all Microsoft Project tasks with the same work center and WBS element can be mapped to one network activity in SAP. Resource assignments can be linked with activity elements, and other SAP network objects – like material components and milestones – can be included in synchronizations.
- A key integration feature is the exchange of forecasts for internal and external costs. Planned values can be aggregated to any accounting parameters (like WBS element, internal order, cost center, activity type etc.). They can then be transferred into SAP activity input and primary cost planning, based on fiscal year periods. This is the ideal way to keep SAP and Microsoft Project cost plans synchronized by avoiding too many details in SAP.
- Alongside forecasts, PSLink can transfer posted time from Microsoft Project to SAP CATS or to CO activity allocation documents. It can also import actual work from SAP into Microsoft Project.
- PSLink also gives you the flexibility to transfer any other data from or to any SAP module by configuring update direction, conditions, mappings and filter criteria.
